# HOUSE RULES

---

- No smoking. Smoking is prohibited in all areas, except the stone patio around the fire pit. Vape or e-cigarettes are considered smoking.
- No pets.
- Guest count on your reservation must be accurate and any changes in guest count should be okayed by the host prior to your stay. If the guest count provided is inaccurate, the host reserves the right to charge an additional \$250 per person per day.
- No parties!!! NO EVENTS. Quiet hours are strictly enforced from 10 PM to 8 AM. Please be especially mindful of volume when outside.
- Parking is restricted to driveway, gravel area above home on Deerwood Drive, and gravel area near boathouse.
- Cabinets marked with "Private" are locked and not available to guests.
- **Motorized boats housed in boathouse are not included in the property rental.** Please do not climb on, move the lifts, or tamper with in any way. Pontoon boat may be added to your rental with an additional fee, rental agreement, and security deposit.
- Fires are only permitted in stone fire pit located at the entry of the home. Fires are strictly prohibited along the trail and in the woods of the property.
- Fire pit:
  - Fires should always be supervised by an adult at all times.
  - Fires should be kept to a reasonable size within the fire pit walls.
  - Once finished, please extinguish all fires with nearby hose. Spigot is located to the left of the front door near bushes. Do not allow fires to "burn out" on their own.
  - Please only use the fire pit blankets provided. These are wool and safe to use around flames. Do not use the great room blankets.
- Surveillance cameras - All guests are notified that security cameras are present on the premises. Cameras may be monitored to insure house rules are followed and to maintain the home. If violations are observed, you will be contacted and can be asked to leave the property immediately. No cameras are present in private areas of the home (bedrooms, bathrooms, etc), are located in plain site at entry points and exterior only. They have no audio recordings of any kind.
- General Safety:

- Supervise all children closely. Be especially careful on decks, around waterfall/pond, and at boat house/docks. Use gates to restrict access to areas like diving board and spiral staircase.
- Please be mindful that steps and the trail can be slippery when wet.
- Swim at own risk. Please use floatation devices. Please jump off of end of docks into deeper water only.
- Boathouse umbrellas - Please close umbrellas when not in use. Strong winds can blow and break the umbrellas.
- Unless given expressed written permission from the host, furniture is not to be moved from original locations. Indoor furniture is never allowed to be moved to the exterior or vice versa.
- Waterfall - Please supervise all children in this area. Do not rearrange rocks or climb on/around waterfall and pond. Do not throw anything in the water.
- Septic system:
  - Please discard all feminine products, tissues, paper towels, hair, etc. in the trash. Only potties and toilet paper should be flushed.
  - Limit the use of garbage disposals by using the mesh drain covers provided.
  - Please use septic safe toilet paper. Two rolls of TP are provided per bathroom. In the event you need more, please purchase toilet paper marked as "septic safe" ONLY.
- NC Fishing license is required to fish on Lake Lure.
- Trash:
  - Please do not leave any food or beverage trash at boathouse over night! The wildlife will take advantage and make a mess! Please take your trash up nightly and properly dispose in the bear trash cans.
  - All trash placed in main bear cans (in trash house) must be bagged. No loose items such as cups, take out bags, etc. will be picked up.

## SEASONAL LIMITATIONS

---

- Waterfall is turned off during cold weather months (apx. October - March) due to risk of ice dams and pump damage.
- Inside fireplace is turned off during warm months (apx. April - mid October) due to risk of damage to A/C units.

# HOW TO...

---

**Access the home:** A custom entry code is generated for you to enter via the smart lock on the screened porch. This code will be emailed to you prior to your stay. Please feel free to share this access code with all members of your party. This code will expire promptly at 10 AM of your check out day.

**Access the boathouse:** Via walking, trail to the boat house exits the bluestone patio near the fire pit. Follow the trail through the woods until you reach a paved driveway. Follow driveway down the hill, walkway to access the boathouse is on your right hand side.

Via car, exit the driveway by turning right down Deerwood Drive. Follow road past "End city management sign." Walkway to boathouse and gravel parking area located to left.

**Adjust thermostats:** The main home has three thermostats, located in the foyer, loft, and central hallway in basement. Each thermostat can be adjusted individually in the range of 68-80° F in summer and 60-75° F in winter. To operate thermostats, please do not push screen! This can cause the thermostat to temporarily lock and prevent adjustments. To adjust temperature, spin the exterior dial of the thermostat.

The sunroom has a dedicated heat pump unit. The remote for the unit can be found on the wall near the pass thru bar windows. The bottom of the remote slides down to reveal more buttons. Point remote at wall unit and make selections. Wait approximately 2-3 minutes for unit to respond and begin working. Please only operate unit when windows and doors are closed.

Thermostats cont... Unless a guest is sleeping in the area, please shut the doors to the main house and turn off the unit over night.

Access Wi-fi: Network = 148deerwood  
Password = lakelure

Occasional outages can occur, but are rare. If you experience an outage, please contact host for assistance.

Use the TV's: Remotes for the great room TV can be found on the center coffee table. Remotes for the sunroom TV can be found on the sectional ottoman.

Use the speakers: The whole house speaker receiver is located to the right of the television in the great room. Turn on the receiver power. Turn on the bluetooth feature on your device. Connect to RX-A670. Select music to play on your device. In order for bluetooth to remain connected, your device must be a reasonable distance from the receiver.

Speakers are located on the upper deck and throughout the main living space of the home. Please be considerate of neighbors when adjusting volume and music choices.

Troubleshooting: If you are having difficulty connecting your device, please make sure anyone from your party who may have used device earlier is fully disconnected.

Use water "toys": Two single kayaks, one double kayak, canoe, stand up paddle board, life jackets, pool noodles, large "island" raft, and individual rafts can be found in the boat house. Please use care and team lift when placing any of them in the water. Once finished using, please lift the boats from the water and return them to their racks on the walls of the boathouse. Place rafts and noodles inside of boathouse where you found them.

Floatation devices are required by law for children under the age of 13. When leaving the cove area on kayaks or canoes, police may require proof of floatation device on vessel for all persons, regardless of age.

Use the gas grill: Remove cover and set aside. Gas valve is located on the ground to the right of the grill. Open the valve so that the knob points up and down. Press and hold igniter down firmly while using knobs on grill to light. When done with using, please use provided grill brushes to keep clean. Please immediately turn off gas supply valve after use. Once cooled, please re cover the grill (prevents water damage).

Use game table: Table in sunroom has three levels: wood surface, poker, and bumper pool. To use poker table, team lift top surface and flip over to reveal felt table. To play bumper pool, lift off top table and carefully set aside on a soft surface such as nearby rugs. When completed with games, please kindly replace table top with wood side up.

Pool cues are mounted above bar windows. Poker set, other asst. games and puzzles are located in the entry closet near the front door.

Empty trash: Main garbage cans are located at the top of the driveway. Due to wildlife in the area (thinks BEARS, not cute raccoons), we respectfully request that you immediately place all household trash in the bear resistant cans at the top of the driveway and make sure latch is secured. **ALL TRASH MUST BE BAGGED IN TRASH BAGS.** Do not place loose cups, fast food bags, etc. in the main cans. Extra trash bags are provided below the kitchen sink.

Trash pick up day is Monday. Please have trash to cans by 10am



- Recycling: Two recycling bins with lids are provided. The bins are marked 148 and should be placed out for pick up's on Monday's. Please place loose recycling items in bin and firmly snap lids on. These are NOT bear resistant so please do not place anything with food residue in here! Recycling bins can be found near trash structure at top of driveway or in garage.
- Turn lights on Boathouse There is a switch at the top of the boathouse stairs that turns on the pole flood lights and stair lights. Light switches for the boathouse pavillion/bar are located on the post of the structure.
- Boathouse Speakers There is a bluetooth receiver located in the stainless steel cabinet of the bar. The name of the receiver is R-S202 Yamaha. To connect your device, press the bluetooth key on the remote for 3-5 seconds, until "pairing" appears on the receiver screen. You can pair your device at this time. Please note that cell phone service is spotty at the boathouse so streaming music may be difficult. We advise downloading any music you want to listen to while in wifi.
- Use fireplace Fireplace is only available for use during cold weather months. To turn on flame, a labelled switch is located on near the door to the deck (lake side). Please only have fireplace on when an adult is actively monitoring the area and do not leave on over night. Keep in mind that the fireplace will heat up the loft area while in use.

# HOUSE TIPS AND TRICKS

---

No power on dishwasher	We're not sure who thought this was a good idea, but there is a switch underneath each sink that controls the power to the nearest dishwasher. Please verify that the switch is on, wait a minute, then try the dishwasher again.
Drink tables on boat house	These bad boys open and have dry, shady storage! It gets REALLY HOT in the direct sun on the deck so this can be an excellent place to tuck things away (flipflops, phones, etc.).
"Passage" light switches	These are used to light your path from one area of the home to another. Use this if you are shutting all the lights down to go to bed. It will allow you to travel from one area of the house to another and shut them off at each respective stairwell.
Ice/Cooler at boathouse	The drawer in the bar (to the left of the trash pull out's) can be used to store your cooler.
Bath fans	To improve the overall air quality of the home, every full bath is equipped with a special switch on the overhead bath fans. This switch causes the bath fans to run for fifteen additional minutes after you manually switch them off. The bath fans will also turn on and run for ten minutes every hour.
Bath fans continued...	
Overhead fans	The overhead fans in the great room and loft are programmed to turn on everyday in the afternoon and off at 10 PM. This is by design to help circulate the air with the vaulted ceilings. We

advise that the fans be on in the afternoon during all warm weather, but if you wish to override the automated settings and turn the fans off or on at other times, please DO NOT use the pull chain on the fans. The toggle switches on the wall can be used manually to turn the fans off or on; hold top to turn on or hold the bottom to turn off.

#### Kitchen exhaust

The smoke detector system in the house is VERY sensitive. Please always use down draft exhaust when using range or ovens. To access, press button at countertop level behind range. Exhaust fan will raise from below counter to draft.

# WHERE CAN I FIND...

---

Beach towels:	In walk in closet off foyer
Child safety gates:	In walk in closet in foyer and loft bedroom closet. In addition to the tension gates, two gates are wall mounted at the top/bottom of main floor staircases.
Cleaning products:	Spills and accidents happen. We sincerely appreciate you taking quick effort to clean them up! Miscellaneous cleaning products can be found beneath large kitchen sink.
Cooler bags:	Under sink in mudroom
Dishwasher tabs:	Under each kitchen sink near dishwashers
Extra bed linens:	In closet in main hallway of basement (across from stairs). In case of an accident, extra bed linens are provided. Please be respectful of cleaning staff and only use what you need. Fresh linens are placed on every bed prior to your arrival.
Extra bed pillows:	We get it! Firm and soft pillows are a personal preference and quite frankly, you should get what you want. Many beds in the house offer both soft and firm pillows already in place. In the event you don't have what you need on the bed, extra pillows can be found in the linen closet in the loft (down hallway to bathrooms) or in linen closets in basement (across from stairs).
Extra bath towels:	In closet in main hallway in basement (across from full bathroom) and in linen closet in loft (down hallway to bathrooms).

Extra trash bags:	Under main kitchen sink
First Aid Kit:	Under bathroom sink in bathroom off foyer
Fire pit log grabber:	Hanging near fire pit
Fresh cooking herbs:	For our Chef guests or those who fancy themselves to be, we have fresh herbs growing in large pots near fire pit. Please help yourselves. During most months, basil, rosemary, thyme, and several varieties of mint are available.
Game table things:	Pool cues are sitting on hooks over pass thru bar windows to kitchen. Pool balls are in basket on table. Poker set, other assorted games and puzzles are located in the entry closet by the front door.
Garbage Cans:	Outdoor bear cans are located at top of driveway.
Grilling tools:	Kitchen drawer closest to the lake on wall of kitchen towards sunroom
Kitchen Trash Cans:	In pull out drawer cabinet to the right of the larger kitchen sink
Lake water "toys":	At boathouse, you will find the following: 3 kayaks, canoe, stand up paddle board, oars, rafts, noodles, and floatation devices.
Marshmallow holders:	Hooks near fire pit
Patio chair cushions:	For master loft balcony, cushions can be found in walk in closet in loft.  For chaise lounge on main house deck, cushions can be found in walk in closet off foyer.

Patio cushions cont

For round table on lower main house deck, seat cushions can be found on shelf inside man door of garage (door closest to this table).

\*\*\*After using cushions, please kindly return to their homes so they will be clean and dry for the next guests. In case of an accidental shower, please place cushions in garage to dry.

Toaster:

Upper cabinet to the left of the refrigerator. The cabinet doors swing open and tuck back out of the way. The unit is plugged in at the rear of the cabinet.

# WHERE TO GO

---

## Groceries:

- Ingles, 276 NC-9, Lake Lure, NC 28746
  - Full grocery store and gas station
  - Pro tips: If you are hosting a big group, grab an extra bag of ice near checkout. It is great for keeping up with ice demands on hot days, filling coolers, etc.. Also, get the muffins from the bakery and don't look at the calorie intake. They are soooo good.
- Lawter's Fruit Stand - No known address (read hidden gem)! It is located along the side of Highway US 64 near the intersection Gene Stratton Porter Road and US 64. From the Cedar house, take a left turn on Deerwood Drive. At stop sign, take a right on to Buffalo Shoals Rd. Follow Buffalo Shoals approximately 2 miles until you dead end into US 64 (Highlands Kitchen & Bar restaurant should be on your left). Take a right on to US 64. Follow for approximately 3 miles. When you pass The Lake House restaurant, you have about a mile left. Fruit stand will be on your left hand side.
  - Pro tip: Local honey (Sourwood) and peaches can't be beaten when they are in season. This adorable stand opens and closes at unknown intervals of time, but is generally open on weekends and during peak season.

## Restaurants:

- Appalachia Restaurant at the Lodge at Lake Lure, 361 Charlotte Dr, Lake Lure, NC 28746
  - Headed by the former chef of Medina's bistro, features classic Appalachian staples and higher end dining
  - Fantastic views of Lake Lure and mountain range
  - Pro tip - order anything that has the cinnamon rolls!!! They are house made and delicious.
  - Reservation recommended.
- La Strada at Lake Lure, 2693 Memorial Highway, Lake Lure, NC 28746 - 828.625.1118
  - Italian fare with great views of beach and mountains in downtown Lake Lure
  - Pro tip: Pizza is the way to go here. They have large pizzas with unique toppings. The Asian salad and garlic rolls are always a family favorite as

well. You can choose to dine in and capture great views of the local beach or take carry out. We like to pick up pizzas and enjoy them on the decks of the house. La Strada has a great view, but notttt quite as good as The Cedar House.

- Open hours change seasonally. Please call ahead to confirm service hours.
- Veranda Restaurant at the 1927 Lake Lure Inn, 2771 Memorial Highway, Lake Lure, NC 28746 - 888.434.4970:
  - Gorgeous fine dining restaurant in the fully restored historic inn.
  - Pro tip: Amazing formal brunch with lots of goodies. Bloody Mary bar is open 12- 2 PM.
  - Reservations recommended
- The Lake House, 1020 Memorial Highway, Lake Lure, NC 28746 - 828.625.4075
  - Casual lake front restaurant serving American Cuisine
  - Pro tip: Call ahead during peak season on nice days. It gets very busy around meal times. If you are renting our pontoon boat for your stay, you can travel by water and park at their docks for your meal.
- The Esmerelda Inn & Restaurant, 910 Main Street, Chimney Rock, NC 28720 - 828.625.2999
  - Beautiful restaurant set within the historic Esmerelda Inn, featuring chef curated meals of local meats and vegetables
  - Pro tip: Ask about scheduling the "Chef's table." It is a unique dining experience where guests have the ability to view the chef preparing their meal. They also offer cooking classes with the chef
  - Reservations required.
- Highlands Kitchen & Bar: 454 Memorial Hwy. Lake Lure NC 28746- 828.436.4023
  - A full service restaurant and bar which overlooks Lake Lure and mountains.
  - Recently opened in 2021. Reviews have been good. The menus, both food and cocktail, look awesome :)
  - Reservations recommended.

  - Nestled along the Rocky Broad river, you will find a collection of shops, restaurants, and stores. It is popular visit spot with tourists to pick up souvenirs. Be sure to take the creek walk.

  - A soft sand beach on Lake Lure with an attached kids' water park with slides and water games
  - Admission fee applies.
- Chimney Rock State Park: 431 Main Street, Chimney Rock, NC 28720
  - Offers stunning panoramic views of the lake and surrounding regions
  - Pro-tip: On clear days, you can see the flag on Chimney rock from the decks of the Cedar house!

### Attractions:

- The Biltmore Estate: 1 Lodge Street, Asheville, NC 28803
  - A huge private estate built by the Vanderbilts now operating as a museum and tourist attraction.
  - Pro-tip: The grounds are stunning and the gardens themselves are worth a trip. It is especially beautiful in the winter while decorated for the holidays.
- Tryon International Equestrian Center: 25 International Blvd. Mill Spring NC 28756
  - A huge venue hosting equine competitions with riders and horses from all over the world. Watch hunter/jumping, dressage, and various competitions across numerous classes and skill.

- Admission to all horse shows is free and open to the public. If you've never been to a horse show, check out the FAQ section and Horse Show 101 on the TIEC's website. Carousel rides are free too:)
- During non-competition weeks, other festivals and concerts are often held at the venue.

  - Local company specializing in providing water sports, world class ski boats, and lessons
  - Our opinion: This is the best way to learn a watersport on Lake Lure. Or, if you are experienced, this is best way to get a great tow on a luxury, high end ski boat.
  - Boats available for rent by hour and day.

## Golf:

- Apple Valley Golf Course - 309 Winesap Road, Lake Lure, NC 28746 - 828.694.3043
  - A Don Maples designed course that was once named the “most beautiful mountain golf course” by Golf Digest.
  - Our opinion: Our favorite course. Lots of ups and downs combined with undulating greens. Unbeatable mountain views from the back nine. Fairways and greens are always in great shape. Always a fun course to play.
- Bald Mountain Golf Course - 112 Mountain Boulevard, Lake Lure, NC 28746 - 828.694.3042
  - A W.B. Lewis designed course, sitting beneath Bald Mountain.
  - Fun Fact: Scenes from the original Dirty Dancing movie were shot on the 16th hole.

- Our opinion: We prefer Apple Valley to the Bald Mountain course. It is an up and down “target” golf course. Several hidden shots required. Not for beginners.

- Big Bradley Falls - 5436 Holbert Cove Road, Saluda, NC 28733
  - Gorgeous hike along a stream featuring views of 90 foot waterfall
  - About 40 minutes from Lake Lure
  - Pro tip: This one requires crossing a stream. You may rock hop during most times, but amphibious hiking shoes would be highly advised.
  - Full details and videos of hike:
- Little Bradley Falls - 5436 Holbert Cove Road, Saluda, NC 28733
  - A rewarding hike with a triple tiered 50 foot waterfall
  - If it has rained recently, you will need to cross a stream.

- Party Rock -
  - A moderately strenuous hike up an old mining road that is a family favorite. You will be rewarded with epic views of the lake and most likely, will be the only ones on the trail. Enjoy!
  - Directions: From Lake Lure Beach take 64W .6 miles and turn right on Boys Camp Rd. Continue 2.1 miles and turn left on Carson Way. Continue .7 miles. Go up the narrow paved drive just past the entrance to Blue Heron Point Gated Community and park. You will park off to the right in the grass. It is not marked as parking for the trail head. Walk .2 miles up the dirt road to the trailhead on the left side of the road. Approximately 1 mile in you reach a side trail to the left that takes you to Party Rock – just past the truck in the trees – you’ll see.
- Catawba Falls - 3074 Catawba River Road, Old Fort, NC 28762
  - A two part hike offering stunning views of a cascading 100 foot waterfall. It has something for beginners and more experienced hikers. The first part of the hike is easy and gorgeous. The second phase is more strenuous and not for small children.

### Wine and Spirits:

- Hickory Nut Gorge Brewery: 461 Main Street, Chimney Rock, NC
  - Local microbrewery with awesome decks that literally sit on top of the river and a revolving selection of house brews and other featured brews.
- St. Paul Mountain Vineyard: 588 Chestnut Gap Road, Hendersonville, NC 28792 - 828.685.4002
  - Cute as can be tasting room with daily tours and reasonable tastings
  - Opinion: OUR FAVORITE. Hands down. If you are in it for the wine, then this is for you. They offer several great bottles and often sell out.
  - Pro tip: In the evenings during the summer and on the weekend, they often have live musical performances and food trucks on site. If you are inclined to enjoy some ciders after your wine, St. Paul also owns a cider house and is just a short drive away.
- St. Paul Cidery: located just down the road from St. Paul Mountain Vineyard tasting room (see above)
  - A restored, converted barn with a gorgeous cider tasting room on the upper floor. Even if you aren't into cider, you should swing by and check out this restoration. It is a beauty.
  - Opinion: The cider tasting is super fun. It will take you from sweet to dry and through various apples. The bartenders are always friendly and knowledgeable.
- Burntshirt Vineyards: 2695 Sugarloaf Road, Hendersonville, NC 28792
  - A picturesque mountain winery offering tours and a spacious tasting room
  - Opinion: The wines are a bit young, but they are getting better every year. The grounds and surroundings are worth a visit.
  - They also have a restaurant
- Overmountain Vineyards: 2012 Sandy Plains Road, Tryon, NC 28782
  - Owned by a father/daughter wine making team, they have arguably the most beautiful setting of all the local vineyard tasting rooms.
  - Pro tip: The SANGRIA is amazingggg!
- Parker Binns Vineyard: 2275 Whiteside Rd, Mill Spring NC 28756
  - Family owned and run. Bob, one of the founders, can usually be found behind the bar. Karen, his wife and founder as well, is often an entertaining barista. Ask about their history! It's a very entertaining story!

A: That is the sleeping lady. If you look closely at the mountains, you will see the silhouette of a woman lying down.

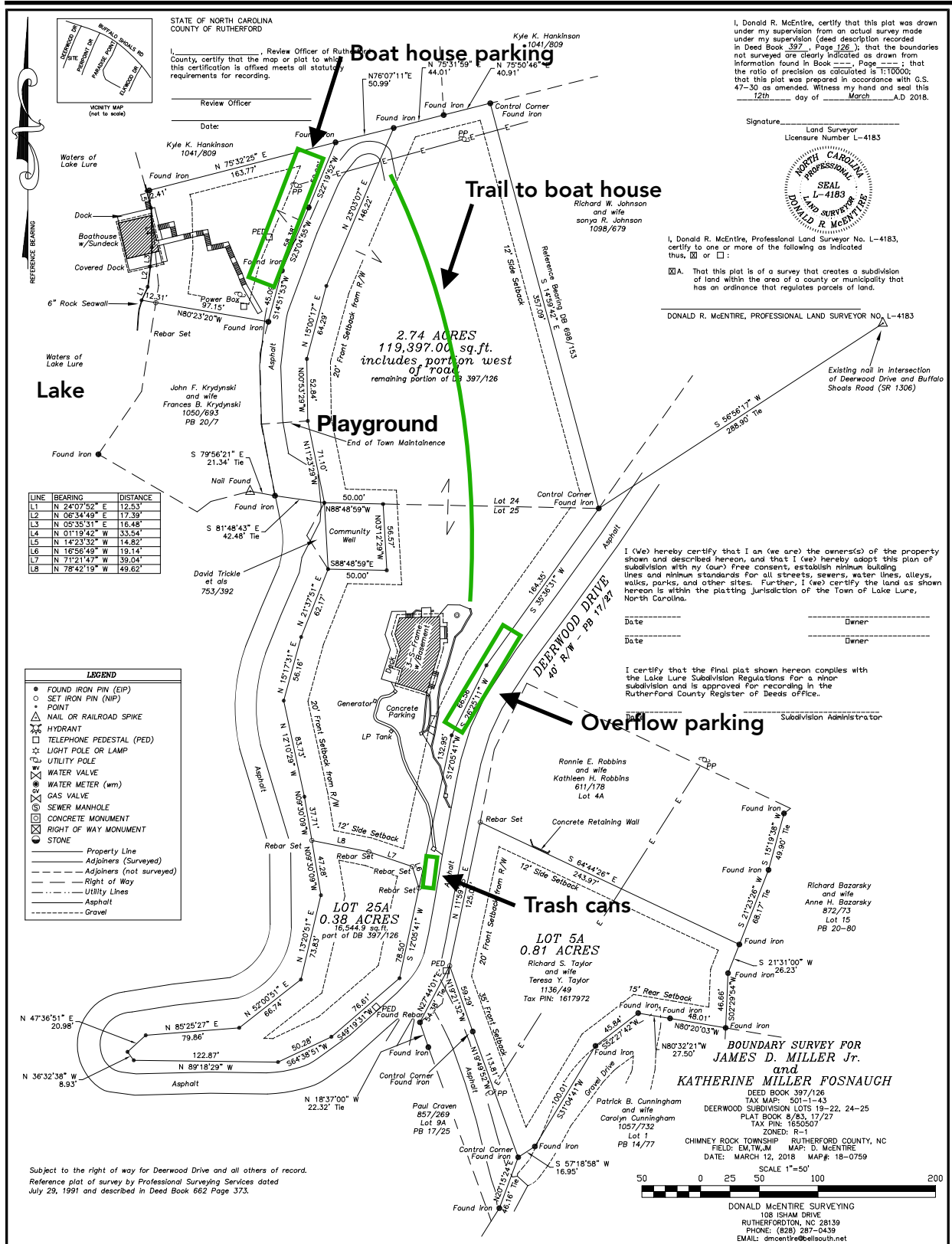
Q: What are the super loud animal sounds at night? It sort of sounds like crickets on steroids.
